Nafferton in Bloom informed the meeting the it was proposed to removed the Dog Wood from the triangle (Driffield Road/New Road area) and replace with trees – Parish Council advised that written agreement must be obtained from ERYC before any new planting took place and the Parish Council given a copy of the permission.

W139 Nafferton Recreation Club

The New Build maintenance/running costs – it was agreed the Council go ahead based on those being the best estimate that could be made on the information available - Councillor Tait proposed that there should be no press release on the New Build until after planning permission had been granted

Councillor Wortley proposed that the new build should be named Feoffee Hall and the Nafferton Recreation Club with the agreement of the descendents of William Cook should be named the William Cook Recreation Centre – seconded Councillor Tait – all in favour

Councillor Wortley proposed that the circulated new layout proposal for the Recreation Club should be approved seconded Councillor Darbinson – all in favour – March agenda
