23/00584/PLF – Erection of a single storey extension to rear following removal of existing conservatory, construction of dormer to rear roof slope and alteration to existing dormer to front – 28 Hall Close, Nafferton

Tree application:

23/00600/TCA – Nafferton Conservation Area – Remove 1 Horse Chestnut tree due to it being impaired by a neighbouring large Beech tree, remove 1 dead/dying Horse Chestnut tree, remove 1 Horse Chestnut Tree due to poor form/condition.
