Planning:

23/00584/PLF – Erection of a single storey extension to rear following removal of existing conservatory, construction of dormer to rear roof slope and alteration to existing dormer to front – 28 Hall Close, Nafferton

Tree application:

23/00600/TCA – Nafferton Conservation Area – Remove 1 Horse Chestnut tree due to it being impaired by a neighbouring large Beech tree, remove 1 dead/dying Horse Chestnut tree, remove 1 Horse Chestnut Tree due to poor form/condition. Remove c1 Sycamore tree due to multiple boles, is disfigured and overgrown/swamping the venerable Yes, move 1 Horse Chestnut tree, remove 1 Elder Tree as it growing against a grade II listed churchyard wall, crown reduce 2 Beech trees and 1 Horse Chestnut tree by up to 3.6 metres, remove 1-2 boles from 1 Sycamore tree due to the boles disfiguring the tree, crown reduce 1 dead larch tree to make safe and leave to support rambling rose. Pollard 1 sorbus x thuringiaca at 2 metres – land south west of Rectory Farmhouse, Rectory Close, Nafferton

Planning decision:

22/01990/STPLFE – Construction of sub-surface cable route from Drax Power Station to Fraisthorpe Coastline with associated accesses and temporary construction compounds in association with the Scotland to England Green Link - granted
