Grateful thanks are expressed to all who have supported us through the last number of years. The Stall on the Wall has proved very popular and raised over £30,000.

Grant funders include Nafferton Feoffees, Nafferton Millennium Committee, The Horace Taylor Trust, The Benefact Trust, Trustees For Methodist Church Purposes, The Hunter Rowe Trust, Congregational and General Fund, plus our own fundraised monies with table top sales, lunches, scarecrow festival and other events.

The Parish Council meet on the second Tuesday of each month at 7.30 pm at The Recreation Club – these meetings are public and open for anyone to attend.

The Parish Council lamented the death of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II and a declaration of allegiance to King Charles III was declared on behalf of the Parish Council by Councillor Sawyer at a short Ceremony on Jubilee Gardens on Sunday 11 September.

<u>New Bench</u> – A new bench has been sited on the corner of Howe Lane, this has kindly been donated by two village families and we hope it will be appreciated by many people wishing to take a rest. The bench is made from recyclable products so will require little or no maintenance. Thank you to the families who have donated the bench, we are sure that it will prove to be a valuable asset to the area.

<u>Jubilee Play Park</u> – The major refurbishment of the Park is now complete (just one or two cosmetic bits to complete) we hope that there will be many families from the village and surrounding area who will visit the Park and enjoy the facilities. **Please note:** Under no circumstances at all are any dogs allowed in The Jubilee Play Park **except** for Assistance Dogs.

<u>Village Maintenance</u> - Village maintenance is always ongoing and you will still see Ross around the village carrying out some jobs. The summer schedule is now coming to a close, this has been an unusual year but we thank the residents, Nafferton in Bloom and Ross for keeping the village looking at its best The two Telephone Kiosks have now been painted and looking very smart.

<u>Dog Fouling</u> – Please be a responsible dog owner and carry a bag at all times to collect, take home and bin any excrement from your dog.

The Parish Council have to follow the guidelines as set out by ERYC and details are available on the ERYC web site for reporting any dog fouling in the Parish

The Parish Council are regularly contacted by residents with concerns regarding the parking of motor vehicles in the village, and it would help relieve some congestion if households with garage and parking areas on site would park their vehicles within their own curtilage
