Nafferton Bells Report 2010

Early January saw the preparations begin for the installation of the bells.

The organ has been cocooned to prevent any dust from entering but the organist will still be able to play it.

The drives to the clock faces have been removed to allow the bells to be taken up through the trap door into the bell chamber.

During the 2<sup>nd</sup> week in January the joiner and electrician began building the floor of the ringing chamber and fixing the lighting in the tower.

Notices have been placed in the Driffield Times and the Village shops saying that the clock will be out of action for approximately 3 months while the work is being carried out.
